PROCLAMATION HENDERSON PAVILION

WHEREAS, Boyd Henderson has continuously served the citizens of the City of Tuscola since 1981, as Alderman for Ward III from 1981-1985, City Clerk from 1985-1989, and again as Alderman for Ward III from 1989-2017; and

WHEREAS. in his 36 years of service as an elected official, Boyd Henderson has attended approximately 864 City Council meetings and countless committee meetings at three different City Halls, and he has been involved in every facet of City operations through his various committee assignments; and

WHEREAS, Boyd Henderson has taken part in numerous projects and initiatives of the City, including the purchase of the water company, implementation of Tax Increment Financing, development of the outlet mall and surrounding areas, development of the downtown area, and construction of two new wastewater treatment facilities; and

WHEREAS, Boyd Henderson has performed his duties well and honorably, and he has always voted with the best interests of the citizens of Tuscola at heart. Boyd has also mentored new city council members and has, for several years, served as Mayor pro tempore as the senior Alderman, in addition to being the resident historian for the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Daniel J. Kleiss, Mayor of the City of Tuscola, do hereby proclaim that the South Pavilion at Ervin Park shall hereafter be known as "Henderson Pavilion" in honor and recognition of Boyd Henderson's service to the <u>City of Tuscola</u>.
