Tourism Board Meeting March 17, 2014

The meeting was called the meeting to order approximately 8:30 am. In attendance: Ashley Swinford, Donna Kidwell, Drew Hoel, Randy Hastings, Phyllis Truitt, Devon Flesor Story, and Anna Marx.

Motion to approve the minutes from the February 17, 2015 Board meeting made by Devon, seconded by Drew. All in favor, motion passed.

Motion to approve the bills list from 2/13/15-3/13/15 in the amount of \$2,827.13 made by Donna, seconded by Randy. All in favor, motion passed.

Old Business:

Anna recapped the ACOI Tourism Board Business and Community leaders dinner for the board. She thought they had a great crowd, approximately 100 attendees. She passed out the information provided at the meeting for the board to review. Anna thought they had a good representation from each community and had a lot of positive feedback.

Donna updated the board on the Rural Life Show for the board. She was very pleased to see the show highlighted in a national antique publication, Action Auction. She believes the show is growing and has a lot of interest for the November show.

Anna updated the board on the Market on Main. She has booked several bands, but has 5 openings left to fill. Two of the bands that have played in the past are not able to play this year. Anna asked if the board knows of any local bands that could play to let her know. She also has almost all the market sponsors scheduled; she is just waiting to hear back from the last few.

Anna informed the board on planning for Sparks in the Park. She explained she is having a difficult time finding entertainment to fill the afternoon because the event is taking place on the holiday this year. The board suggested contacting local church choir groups, the Methodist bell ringers, and Chief AJ. So far scheduled to perform she has someone to do face painting, magician, and strong man. Also PTO games and inflatable, parade and 5K will all be returning this year. She hopes to have the boy's basketball sponsor the 3 on 3 tournament and cheerleader to sponsor mud volleyball, she is still waiting on confirmation.

Representatives from WEIU presented the "This is Our Story" production. They explained that this is a fundraising effort for WEIU and their new goal is \$10,000. They also explained that production would include 30 to 35 storytellers with 2 to 6 minute stories. The first step would be to gather interested storytellers in April. At this meeting, WEIU will give the storytellers direction on how they can record their stories and collect visual props (pictures and newspaper articles). Lastly, they will have an all day filming event that will take place in Tuscola. Storytellers will schedule to be recorded telling their story. Once that is complete, WEIU will edit the content and create the documentary. They plan to have the first airing in July. The board decided after much discussion that they would be willing to support this project monetarily, if WEIU is able to obtain most of the funds. A suggestion was made to contact WEIU in a month to see how much supported they have received for this project. The main hesitation from the board is the value of the project and if would generate any visitors or patrons to Tuscola businesses. The board will discuss at the next meeting.

New Business:

A grant was submitted by Kiwanis for their annual Easter Egg Hunt. The group is asking for \$450 to pay for newspaper ads, a banner, and fliers to be printed. A motion to approve was made by Drew and seconded by Randy. All in favor, motion passed.

Drew made a motion to adjourn and was seconded by Randy. All in favor, motion passed.
