



## Season Admission Passes

Season Passes for the Tuscola Pool are sold to allow one-price access to the pool for all hours of operation. Season pass prices are as follows:

The RESIDENT rate applies only to those persons/households that are located within the legal corporate boundaries of the City of Tuscola.

After the pool officially opens (usually the Saturday preceding Memorial Day), season passes must be purchased at the pool for the following rates.

- FAMILY RATE - RESIDENT - \$90.00
- FAMILY RATE - NON-RESIDENT - \$100.00
- SINGLE RATE - RESIDENT - \$55.00
- SINGLE RATE - NON-RESIDENT - \$60.00
- SENIOR RATE - RESIDENT - \$35.00
- SENIOR RATE - NON-RESIDENT - \$40.00
- DAILY PASS - \$4.00 PER DAY PER PERSON
- COUPON BOOK - 10 ADMISSIONS FOR \$30.00

POOL PARTY RATES—\$125.00 for the first 50 people in attendance, \$2.00 for each additional person.

Family passes are intended for use only by members of ONE family who continually reside in the same residence (typically will be the same as the dependents allowed to be claimed on a federal tax return). Babysitters are not allowed on a family pass as a family member. Similarly, grandchild-

ren who do not live with and/or are not dependent on the grandparents would not be allowed on the grandparents' pool pass.

All season pass holders will be required to fill out an emergency contact form on their family. Updates are the responsibility of the member.

Senior rates are allowed for individuals over the age of 60 on May 1 of the pool season.

EVERYONE being admitted to the pool is required to pay admission.

Patrons are allowed to leave and return once per day. Management has ultimate decision on admittance.



## Operating Season and Hours

The Tuscola Pool regular operating season and hours of operation are as follows:

The pool will open for the season on Memorial Weekend (Saturday, May 26) and close for the season at the beginning of the Tuscola CUSD #301 school year. Operating hours are 12:30 P.M. to 7:30 P.M. daily.

Pool party reservations are available on a first come basis by calling the pool at 217-253-4932. Morning party hours are 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Evening party hours are 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Adult Swim daily 11:30-12:30 for regular admission price which allows patrons use of the pool for the day, or admittance under a pool pass.

The pool is not responsible for lost or stolen

items. Baskets are provided for the safeguard of personal items.

The Tuscola Pool reserves the right to deviate from these hours for any of several conditions out of the control of the management of the pool or that are operationally necessary. Listed below are some common reasons for closing the pool.

1. The pool will close any time the temperature is below 70° F.
2. The pool will close when audible thunder or visible lightning is detected by the management or staff or if management or staff deems other dangerous weather conditions exist.
3. The pool will close anytime repairs or maintenance necessitate closure. A sign will be posted as to the anticipated re-opening time/date. All measures will be taken to get work completed to allow re-opening as quickly as possible.
4. The pool will close at any time staffing is not sufficient to maintain safety and legal requirements. Management will take action to ensure staffing issues are kept to a minimum.
5. When pool attendance drops to a level that it is no longer operationally feasible to keep staff on the clock, the management may decide to close the facility for the day.

Pool admission passes are purchased at the customer's risk. When pool management or staff determines that the pool must close for these or other unforeseen reasons, NO refund or partial refund of season or daily admission passes will be considered.



To ensure the safety and family atmosphere of the pool, we DO NOT ALLOW:

- Smoking within the fence.
- Inappropriate Language.
- Inappropriate displays of public affection.
- No dirty/muddy shoes on the pool deck.
- Throwing of children or having them on shoulders of another person.
- Sitting along the diving well.
- Running.
- Diving of the sides.
- Fighting/Pushing/Shoving.
- Swimming in street clothes.
- Excessive bouncing on diving boards.
- Rafts, rings and throwing objects are the left to the discretion of the manager and lifeguards.

### FOOD

Outside food is allowed with management being allowed to search through any cooler brought into the pool area. Food must be consumed in the concession area. Clean up is your responsibility. Parties are encouraged to use the picnic area outside the pool area for consumption of food.

### DIVING BOARD

No arm flotation rings or goggles allowed. Must be able to go off straight and swim to closest ladder. Life jackets are allowed.

### BABY POOL

Not under lifeguard supervision. Must have adult supervision within fenced baby pool area. Swim Diapers are required on those not potty trained. Appropriate for ages 5 and under.
